



## THE MODEL/ JERRY HALL

**G**race Jones was her roommate, Rolling Stones frontman Mick Jagger her husband and other famous musicians wrote songs about her. Jerry Hall had it all. One of the “It” models of the '70s, her trademarks were her long blond hair and height of six feet. In her golden era Hall graced almost every high fashion magazine, including the Italian *Vogue* and *Cosmopolitan*, earning a salary of \$1,000 per day. She modeled for Yves Saint Laurent, became the muse of fashion illustrator Antonio Lopez and posed for Helmut Newton. What followed was a turbulent relationship with Jagger that resulted in him cheating on her multiple times and her feeling like she was just his accessory. But Hall proved that she was more than that. A role in Tim Burton's *Batman* was her first big hit as an actress, then roles in British television shows followed, as well as numerous stage performances. Today, she is a mother of four and she did pass on her talent—to her daughter, Georgia May Jagger, who is now a renowned model for Chanel, Miu Miu, Versace and Vivienne Westwood.
